We are seeking 3 passionate and dedicated youth to fill in the Peer Educator positions. The *Queer & Trans Asian Youth (QTAY) When You're Ready (WYR) Project* is a project funded by the Toronto Urban Health Fund.

Responsibilities

- Work in collaboration with the Youth Program Coordinator and other Peer Educators
- Attend mandatory Peer Leader trainings and meetings
- Develop and co-facilitate 4 WYR Cycles, with each Cycle containing 8 sessions
- Develop and co-facilitate QTAY weekly digital drop-ins for WYR youth participants relating to their 2SLGBTQIAP+ identity
- Develop and co-facilitate QTAY monthly drop-ins for youth relating to their 2SLGBTQIAP+ identity
- Promote QTAY events on social media outlets such as Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram
- Outreach to different community organizations and schools to promote the QTAY WYR Project and other QTAY programs
- Aid in evaluating program, incorporating feedback, and maintaining statistics

Lived experience in the East and Southeast Asian 2SLGBTQIAP+ community
Experience in workshop planning, group facilitation, and community outreach, especially with youth
Experience working in a team setting with excellent interpersonal & communication skills
Thorough understanding of ACAS mission & values, HIV/AIDS stigma and discrimination, 2SLGBTQIAP+ issues, and healthy sexuality
Self-directed and willingness to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends
Ability to work under a youth-friendly, queer-positive, sex-positive, and anti-oppressive framework
Ability to speak and facilitate workshops in one or more East and Southeast Asian languages an asset
